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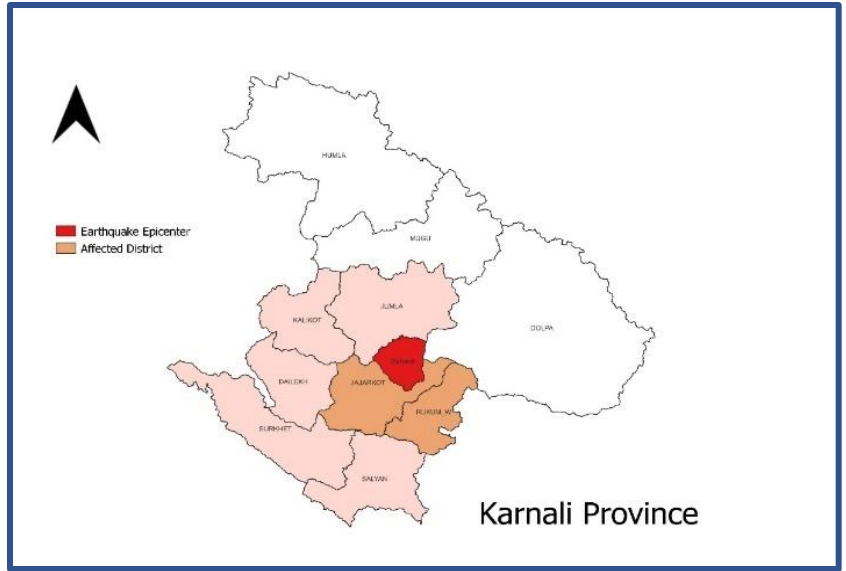

Highlights

1. In Rukum West 28354 and in Jajarkot 20445 temporary shelters have been constructed and construction of temporary shelter is ongoing both in Jajarkot and Rukum West.
2. Essential equipment support is ongoing at birthing center of 7 Health facilities of Jajarkot and 3 Health Facilities of Rukum West District.



Situation Overview

On the night of November 3, 2023, a 6.4 magnitude earthquake struck the Jajarkot and Rukum West district of Karnali Province with its epicenter located in Ramidanda, Jajarkot district, at 11:47 PM. Following the initial earthquake, numerous aftershocks occurred, causing fear among the local population. The ongoing aftershocks have compelled residents to evacuate their homes and seek to stay in open areas. A total of 18 local governments are affected where Jajarkot and Rukum West are severely affected in terms of human casualties, and damage to houses in Karnali Province.

Health & Nutrition Cluster Decision made through PHSD meeting on 2080-11-30 at 10:30 AM

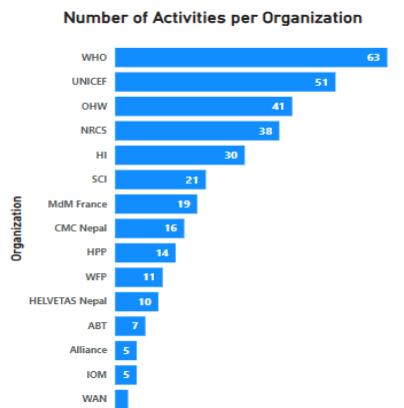
1. The prevention of health problems that arise due to the devastating earthquake in Jajarkot on 2080/07/17 in support and coordination in between Health Services Directorate, Ministry of Social Development, Provincial Health Logistic Management Center, various governmental and non-governmental organizations, through regular surveillance, data collection, treatment and rehabilitation has been completed successfully, and it was decided to work in close coordination and cooperation with each other and carry out regular surveillance activities.
2. For the prevention and control of different types of epidemics that may appears in the province, it was decided to activate and updates on the Rapid Response Team of districts, and local level, along with publishing and broadcasting

various informative materials with more priority to the municipalities of the earthquake-affected districts. Further, decided to conduct Provincial Rapid Response Committee meeting on March 17, 2024.
3. According to the schedule of the semi-annual review meeting of health offices/ public health offices in Karnali province, it was decided that the different group will participate in the review of the relevant district with partner organizations led by the health service directorate and submit the report of the respective district to the health service
4. The measles and rubella vaccination campaign that has been conducted so far has been successfully completed and in some municipalities of Humla and Dolpa districts that have not been completed, the necessary coordination and cooperation will be carried out to conduct the vaccination campaign and It was decided that health service directorate will be appointed to represent the district and vaccinations will be conducted in the coming days also it was decided to conduct vaccine training/orientation for health workers.
5. It was decided to conduct Integrated Supervision jointly by the Ministry of Social Development, Provincial Health Logistic Management Center and various partner organizations under the leadership of Health Service Directorate in Mugu, Jajarkot, Dolpa and Humla districts with Indicator Low Performance of public health/health service offices in
6. One Heart, which works as a partner organization in this province, provided information regarding the Simulation base mentorship program in future.

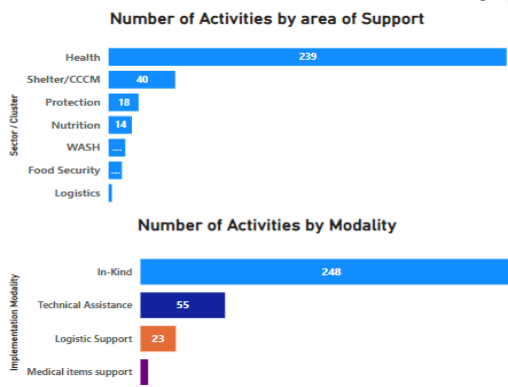

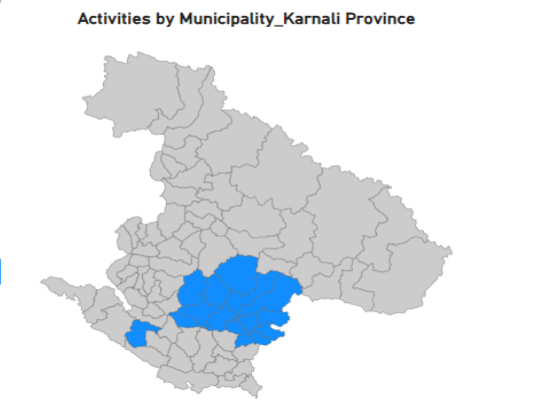
